Professor Nigel Hunt

Nigel Hunt qualified in dentistry from Guy's Hospital in 1974 and subsequently gained the Fellowship of Dental Surgery from the Royal Colleges of England, Glasgow and Edinburgh. He became an orthodontic specialist in 1980.



Professor Nigel Hunt

He was appointed Senior Lecturer and Consultant Orthodontist at the Fastman Dental Institute in 1984, before combining the role with that of Consultant Orthodontist at Queen Victoria Hospital, East Grinstead in 1990. He obtained his PhD in 1992 and was appointed Professor and Head of Department of Orthodontics, UCL Eastman Dental Institute and Honorary Consultant at University College London NHS Trust In 1998.

He is currently Chair of the Division of Craniofacial Developmental Sciences. His clinical and research interest is the management of dentofacial deformity. He has written 3 books and contributed to 6 others, has 120 papers in peer reviewed journals, and has supervised 16 PhD and over 150 Masters level degrees.

Nigel is a past-Chairman and President of the British Orthodontic Society and Dean of the Faculty of Dental Surgery at the Royal College of Surgeons of England. His awards include Honorary and Life Membership of the British Orthodontic Society, and Life Membership of the World Federation of Orthodontists.

He was appointed as an Officer of the Order of the British Empire in the 2017.

Relationship of Scientific Orthodontic Societies and Commercial Dental Companies

Concerns were raised regarding relationships between Scientic Orthodontic Societies and Commercial Dental Companies. A survey and opinions were sought from FEO members. As a result guidelines / code of ethics have been sent to individual member societies which your country is a member of, regarding the relationships between Orthodontic Societies and Commercial Dental Companies.

A summary of the guidelines issued to member societies follows.

Advertising

Commercial Dental companies should not be present on either website or social media of Orthodontic Societies.

Speakers

It should be a requirement of any Orthodontic Society organizing committee to make clear any commercial links scientific speakers have.

Organisation of Events

Recognition of the participation of Commercial Dental Companies can be Certification of acknowledgement, Classification of Sponsorship.

Pressure from Commercial Dental companies in relation to speaker or organization of events should not be allowed by Orthodontic Societies in any way.

Board Members

Independence and autonomy of the Board Members of Orthodontic Societies is vital to maintain the integrity and prestige of the societies.
